

6. The two ways to live

A) Our way: reject the ruler - God. Result: Condemned by God, facing death and judgment.

B) God's new way: Submit to Jesus as our ruler. Rely on Jesus' death and resurrection. Result: Forgiven by God, Given eternal life.

"Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on him." John 3: 36
