1 Thessalonians 5:11 Therefore encourage one another and build each other [up], just as in fact you are doing.

Acts 20:32 "Now I commit you to God and to the word of his grace, which can build you [up] and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified."

1 Corinthians 14:26 Let all things be done for building [up].

Ephesians 4:29 Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others [up] according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen.

Colossians 2:7 rooted and built [up] in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness.

Acts 20:26 Therefore, I declare to you today that I am innocent of the blood of all men. 27 For I have not hesitated to proclaim to you the whole will of God. 28 Keep watch over yourselves and all the flock of which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers. Be shepherds of the church of God, which he bought with his own blood. 29 I know that after I leave, savage wolves will come in among you and will not spare the flock.....31 So be on your guard!
